



Admission for carers of disabled guests - important information

Carers of our disabled guests may be entitled to free admission at MSV's race events, however this must be arranged prior to the event. Anyone turning up on the day will not be able to obtain a free carer ticket.

To apply for a free carer ticket we require only one of the following documents as proof:

- A copy of the most recent DLA letter for care and/or mobility
- Receipt of Personal Independence Payment (PIP) showing the current entitlement
- A copy of your Attendance Allowance documentation

How to apply

To apply for a carer ticket, either post your proof to the address

below or email carer@msv.com at least one week prior to the meeting you wish to attend. Alternatively, if you have an [Access Card](#), contact us quoting your name and ID number.

Please note that anyone under the age of 13 will be admitted free of charge and will therefore not be eligible for a free carer ticket.

British Superbike Disabled Parking

For British Superbikes (only) there are three locations for disabled parking. Please follow highway signage into the venue. One is at Charlies Exit, another is between Park Corner and Chris Curve, which include a raised

concrete viewing area. At Mountain Valley there is also disabled parking, but please note viewing is not possible from this location.

All parking areas are on grass and the Charlies Exit site is slightly sloping.

Smaller Event Disabled Parking

For all other events, the disabled viewing area between Park Corner and Chris Curve is open and there is additional disabled parking (without viewing) outside the venue office and the visitors car park, both of which are hard standing.
